**Interwoven** is a maker space gallery offering classes in fiber arts and cooking that bring together the history and flavors of the South Coast with its connection to food and cultures from all over the world.

**The Space:** Interwoven is a venue designed by an Artist for Artists and creatives who would like the opportunity to teach a class, host a pop-up, perform, and exhibit work. The venue becomes a gallery, a place to conduct workshops, make fiber related goods, host a themed event, sell what you make on premise, rent equipment to make fabric, art, food and more.

**The Details:** The space seats up to 15 participants. The venue is equipped with moveable tables, chairs, looms, equipment, materials and sinks. Classes and events are varied and all details discussed per client/vendor. Liability insurance is required.

1. Interwoven Gallery
  - A white wall for large scale or collections of work by an individual Artist or group show.
2. Interwoven Maker Space
  - venue for Artist's and creatives to teach classes
  - Fiber Arts: weaving, sewing, embroidery, etc.
    - four weaving looms for teaching/renting
    - contract and custom yardage.
  - Tables and chairs provided for small classes.
  - Natural Dye kitchen for classes.
  - Miscellaneous maker classes/workshops
3. Interwoven Shop
  - Locally sourced, craft made goods from local Artists, Makers, and Creatives
  - Venue and Online store
4. Pop up Café
  - 4 hour themed events
  - Pop up café for sharing stories of food and culture
  - Food events, tastings, featured products of the month etc.
  - Small venue rental
  - Equipped with food grade sinks
  - Supports fresh, seasonal foods, and local businesses
  - **Zero waste** policy
